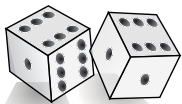

A new kind of dice!

The Warlords have introduced a new six sided dice:

Extreme Dice - the D6e. For the last few thousand years mankind has been gaming with regular six sided dice - D6's as we usually call 'em. For a little while now we've had Average

Dice, of course, with a 2,3,3,4,4,5 layout instead of the regular 1 to 6 - usually used to model predictable or 'steady' responses in gaming. Now there is a third way.

To represent specifically hit or miss responses: that particularly flaky or fanatical unit or a weapon system that either works really well or does almost no damage, you can call in to play

the D6e. This has the numbers 1,1,2,5,6,6 on it's six faces so, as you can see, rolls will be anything but predictable or regular! We'll be using them in some of the Warlords games during the day and you'll get one free in your carrier bag at the door. More will be available - while stocks last - from the Warlords Information stand (T60) at 10p each.

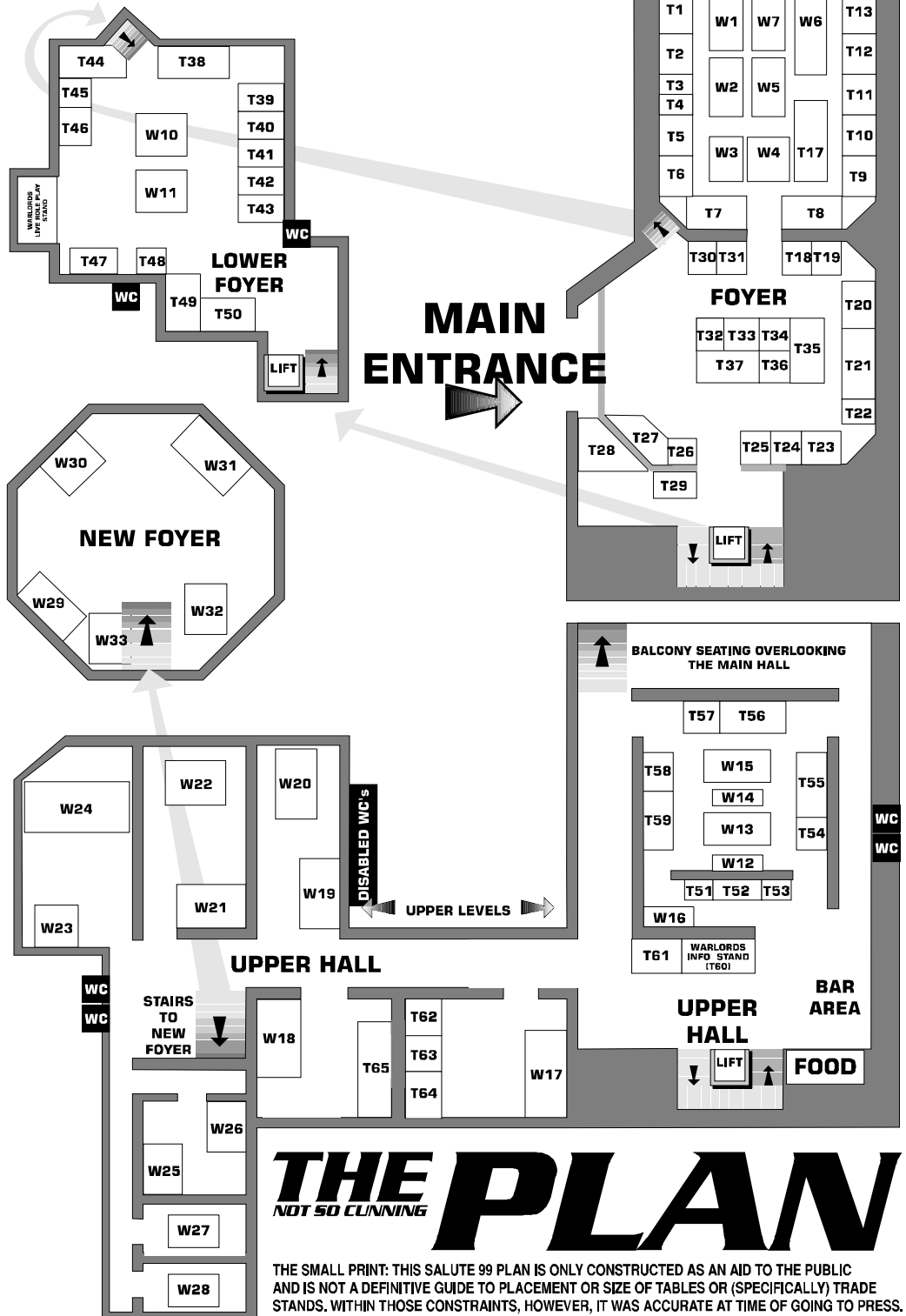
