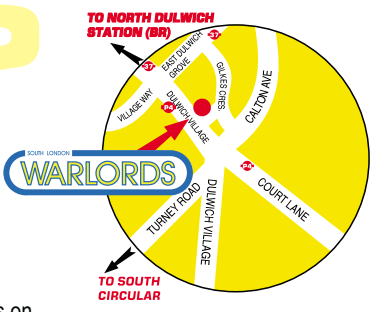


# and the **WARLORDS** are?

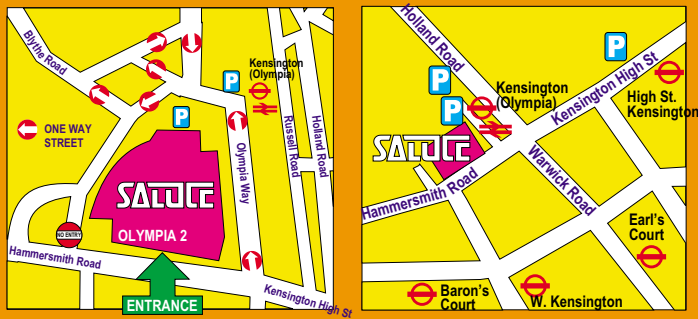

If you're coming by road, Olympia is close to the M3, M4 and M40 and you can book a parking space at the **Olympia car park** - call **0800 050 444**. This is a good idea as the car park does fill up... It's also really easy to get to Salute 2002 Olympia on public transport:

**By Underground:** Kensington Olympia station, in Zone 2, is directly outside Olympia and one stop from Earls Court. A District Line service runs between Earls Court and Kensington Olympia every 10 - 15 minutes.

**By Bus:** Number 9, 10, 27, 28, 29, 49. But bus routes do change: if in doubt, call London Transport Info: 020 7222 1234.

**By Train:** Kensington Olympia railway station is served by Connex South Central's Gatwick Airport-Rugby service and Silverlink's Clapham Junction-Willesden Junction service. London's other major mainline stations are linked to Olympia via the underground network. Again, if in doubt, call British Rail Travel Info: 0345 48 49 50. Heathrow (020 8759 4321).

Last year, the Warlords consolidated Salute at **Olympia 2:** whilst it had been a success in 2000, Salute 2001 was bigger and better with more of everything. Again we asked you - the gamers who come - to fill in a questionnaire which lots of you did and the feedback was very positive. It seemed that you liked the hiring of the extra floor with more space and facilities. The analysis on your feedback can be read on our website ([www.salute.co.uk](http://www.salute.co.uk)). Negative feedback mostly centred around the huge popularity of the **Bring and Buy** and this year we have plans to fix this.

So, this year we've re-hired the extra floor to give you more space. Of course it will also mean that the 'get in' - especially for those with advance Q Buster Badges will be as fast as it was last year.

We've held the entry price at £6. However, like in recent years, you can get in for **FREE** if you spend thirty pounds or more with **Skytrex** on the day (see the coupon overleaf).
